Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Matthew 16:24*)

Discover

1. Why was Jesus so willing to have the children (who, in Jesus’ time were overlooked and thought to be unimportant) come to spend time with Him?
2. Why did the rich young ruler go away disheartened and sorrowful? How do you think that made Jesus feel?
3. How does YOUR heart approach Jesus? How often do you seek to be WITH Him?
4. Can we work for, or earn God’s love? Can we work our way into God’s kingdom? (Read Eph 2:1-10)

Identify

What did the story reveal to you about God, His character, His commands or His promises?

Helpful Questions for Reflection:

What verse stuck out to you the most in this passage?

What personal conviction could you pull from what you read?

Summarize your thoughts into a word or short phrase to give it a "Title"

How are you going to apply what you learned to YOUR life or heart this week?

What is your "response"? What action will you take with what God has spoken to you?
