Quick Review

Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Hint: Micah 6:8*)

Discover

Did you discover something new that you haven’t seen before?

1. What was it that was making the Pharaoh so afraid of the Israelite people?
2. The Pharaoh tried three different ways to stop the Israelite nation from growing. What was motivating him?
3. What were the three ways that Pharaoh tried to stop God from multiplying and blessing His people?
4. What did the Pharaoh tell the Hebrew midwives to do? What was their response?
5. Pharaoh was afraid of the growing Hebrew nation and what that would mean if they became stronger than the Egyptians. The Hebrew midwives were afraid of offending God and what that would mean if they coward into doing something they knew would upset God. How did what they believe affect how they acted?

Identify

What did the story reveal to you about God, His character, His commands or His promises?
