Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Matthew 16:24*)

Discover

Did you discover something new that you haven’t seen before?

1. Jesus heals a crippled man. Could he have healed himself? Do you think he felt trapped?
2. Jesus also heals a man crippled in sin. Levi. Could he have healed himself from sin? Could he have just stopped sinning and made himself a person without sin?
3. Being healed SPIRITUALLY requires a miraculous healing just like the crippled man. Sin is anything we think, say, do or don’t do that doesn’t please God. Read Romans 3:23 and Romans 6:23. According to those scriptures, do YOU need to be saved?
4. To FOLLOW Jesus, we have to leave sin behind. We are set from our slavery to sin which results in death to a slavery of righteousness which leads to a LIFE full of abundance spiritually. Just because we are a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17) it doesn’t mean we become SINLESS but it does mean we SIN LESS because we are walking with Jesus, becoming more like Him every day. What are some ways YOU want to be more like Him?
