Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Matthew 16:24*)

Discover

Did you discover something new that you haven’t seen before?

1. What was Jesus showing His disciples that He must go and DO in Jerusalem?
2. Why do you think Peter would rebuke Jesus for saying these things? What was he focused on?
3. Jesus tells His disciples, “If anyone would come after me...” what must they do? What are some practical applications, or ways we can DO this?
4. Did Jesus want to die? Why DID He go to the cross? What eternal reward did He BECOME worthy of? (Heb. 5:7-10 & Rev. 5:1-10) - If Jesus was motivated by the next life, how can WE be more like Him?

Identify

What did the story reveal to you about God, His character, His commands or His promises?

Helpful Questions for Reflection:

What verse stuck out to you the most in this passage?

What personal conviction could you pull from what you read?

Summarize your thoughts into a word or short phrase to give it a "Title"

How are you going to apply what you learned to YOUR life or heart this week?
