Quick Review

Grab your notebook to review your “Notes” before working through the following questions from Exodus 6. Before diving into the questions with anyone else it will be helpful for you to refresh your memory of what YOU found as you worked through the D.I.G. sections. **ALSO, PRAY WITH YOUR FAMILY THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT WOULD OPEN YOUR HEARTS AND YOUR MINDS TO HEAR FROM GOD’S WORD!**

Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Hint: Micah 6:8*)

Discover

Did you discover something new that you haven’t seen before?

1. How do you think you’d feel to finally be relieved of the pain of slavery (after calling out to God to save you) only to find yourself faced with a giant, impassible sea with death chasing you down, like Pharaoh and his chariots?
2. God was careful not to lead His people out into war because He didn’t want them to march to war. Why did He turn them back in the wilderness to face the Red Sea?
3. This chapter describes God traveling before, leading His people, as a giant pillar of fire and smoke. What do you think life would be like for the Israelites to walk with Him? (Close enough to have shade during the day and warmth at night.)
4. Read vs. 15. God intentionally tells them to GET MOVING! Almost like He was asking “What are you waiting for? I’ve given you everything you need... PLUS, I’m RIGHT HERE WITH you!” - Is there an area of your life that God may be saying this to you? What is it?

Identify

What did the story reveal to you about God, His character, His commands or His promises?

Helpful Questions for Reflection:

What verse stuck out to you the most in this passage?

What personal conviction could you pull from what you read?

Summarize your thoughts into a word or short phrase to give it a "Title"

How are you going to apply what you learned to YOUR life or heart this week?

What is your "response"? What action will you take with what God has spoken to you?
