## Famplify: Small Group Questions

### Week 7 | Exodus 12 | Passover Picture

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### Quick Review

Grab your notebook to review your "Notes" before working through the following questions from Exodus 6. Before diving into the questions with anyone else it will be helpful for you to refresh your memory of what YOU found as you worked through the D.I.G. sections. **ALSO, PRAY WITH YOUR FAMILY THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT WOULD OPEN YOUR HEARTS AND YOUR MINDS TO HEAR FROM GOD'S WORD!**

### Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Hint: Micah 6:8*)

### Discover

*Did you discover something new that you haven't seen before?*

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1. Read Exodus 12:3. Why do you think God wanted them to kill a spotless lamb?
2. Read Exodus 12:13. Did the Lord need help distinguishing the difference between the Hebrews and the Egyptians? (*He didn't have that problem with any of the other plagues!*)
3. Do you think that, after celebrating this feat for thousands of years, it could become more of a tradition and story than an actual memory for those who celebrated it? How can we relate that to our memory of what Jesus did on the Cross?
4. Read Exodus 12:17 - This Passover feast is what Jesus celebrated with disciples the night before He was crucified. Read Luke 22:19-20. Discuss how God used Moses' story to set up the story for the coming Messiah.
5. God keeps His promises. Acts 1:11 we were given a promise that Jesus would return and with Him, He will be bringing a forever kingdom. Do YOU believe it? What does that mean for you life? Your day?

What personal conviction could you pull from what you read?
