Week 5 | Exodus 6 | Pesky Persistence

Quick Review

Grab your notebook to review your “Notes” before working through the following questions from Exodus 6. Before diving into the questions with anyone else it will be helpful for you to refresh your memory of what YOU found as you worked through the D.I.G. sections. **ALSO, PRAY WITH YOUR FAMILY THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT WOULD OPEN YOUR HEARTS AND YOUR MINDS TO HEAR FROM GOD’S WORD!**

Memory Verse

Can you write down the series memory verse? (*Hint: Micah 6:8*)

Discover

Did you discover something new that you haven’t seen before?

1. Moses has once again been protesting God’s faithfulness (Ch. 5) because he doesn’t think God is keeping His promises. “NOW,” God says, “you will see what I will do...” - Why do you think God waited until now to move?
2. Put yourself in Moses’ shoes... Do you think it would be hard to go back to Pharaoh, let alone your own people, to do what he was commanded to? How would you feel?
3. God is establishing a name for Himself. A name that He wants to be remembered by for eternity. What do you think made Moses believe?
4. Moses was TALKING to the living Creator. The one that created ALL things. He griped, complained... even accused God of not living up to His word! Why do you think God allowed him to do that? Did God need to allow him to do that? Did he even NEED Moses?
5. God wasn’t just a God to Moses. He was a friend, shepherd and FATHER. He grew in a relationship with Moses through this difficult and amazing story as He made the world KNOW that He is a God whose faithful love endures forever. How does knowing this, change YOUR perspective on God?

Identify

What did the story reveal to you about God, His character, His commands or His promises?

What personal conviction could you pull from what you read?
